UNIVISION/TELEFUTURA BOSTON HIRES NEW NATIONAL SALES MANAGER Entravision New England appoints Robert Donner

Boston, MA February 14, 2006 –Entravision Communications Corporation (NYSE: EVC) announced today that Robert Donner has been named National Sales Manager for Entravision New England. Effective immediately, Mr. Donner will oversee national sales for the Univision and Telefutura stations operating in the Boston, Hartford and Springfield markets.

Mr. Donner has over ten years of media sales experience, most recently as National Sales Manager for Tribune Broadcasting in Hartford, CT where he also held the title of Regional Sales Manager. Prior to that, Robert was an account executive for MMT Sales in New York. Mr. Donner received his Bachelors degree from the University of California in Santa Barbara, CA.

Entravision New England is made up of five television properties: WUNI-TV 27 (Univision Boston), WUVN-TV 18 (Univision Hartford), WHTX-LP 43 (Univision Springfield), WUTF-TV 66 (Telefutura Boston) and WUTH-CA 47 (Telefutura Hartford). Univision Boston/Hartford are the most watched Spanish-language television stations in their respective markets. They are home to locally produced programs, *Noticias Univision Nueva Inglaterra*, New England’s only live, local Spanish-language television news program, and *Pachanga Latina*, a weekly music video show now in its thirteenth year of production. Telefutura is the newest Spanish-language Network to serve the Boston and Hartford markets. WUNI-TV, WUVN-TV, WHTX-LP and WUTH-CA are owned and operated by Entravision, and WUTF-TV is owned by Univision Communications Inc. and is locally managed and operated by Entravision.

Entravision Communications Corporation is a diversified Spanish-language media company utilizing a combination of television, radio and outdoor operations to reach approximately 75% of Hispanic consumers across the United States, as well as the border markets of Mexico. Entravision is the largest affiliate group of both the top-ranked Univision television network and Univision's TeleFutura network, with television stations in 20 of the nation's top 50 Hispanic markets. Entravision owns and operates one of the nation’s largest groups of primarily Spanish-language radio stations, consisting of 52 owned and operated radio stations in 20 U.S. markets. Entravision’s outdoor advertising operations consist of approximately 11,100 advertising faces located primarily in Los Angeles and New York. Entravision shares of Class A Common Stock are traded on The New York Stock Exchange under the symbol: EVC.
